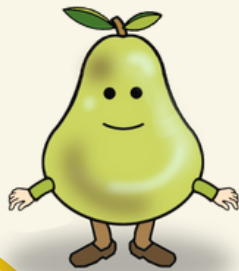
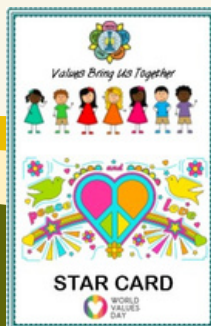

The idea of the 'Values Bring Us Together Project is to help the children draw out the inherent good values using the five values cards.

The children collect cards at random when they complete the tasks mentioned in the checklist 'How to collect the cards'

When they collect the five values cards they achieve the Bronze Values Champion Certificate.

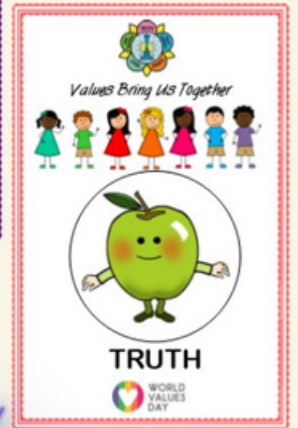
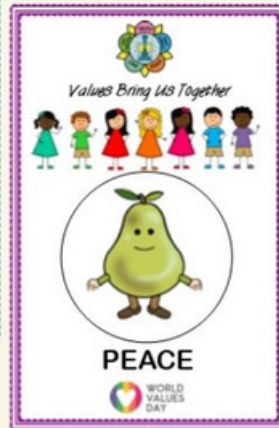
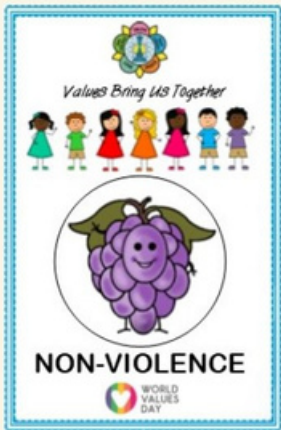
They then go on to get silver and gold certificates.

The Gold certificate will entitle them to receive a free gift of a Values Game or a sponsored activity.

The children can make a treasure box to put in their cards and collect more Quotations of their own. They can then put them in the class Treasure Box. If their Quotation is drawn at random then they can get a card. The children can also be inspired to make their own poster

Strawberry represents **Love**



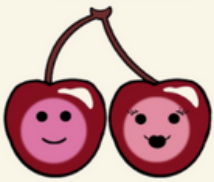
Strawberry is shaped like a heart, red in colour and is sweet. Love is a feeling that makes you feel nice.

Grapes represent **Non-Violence**

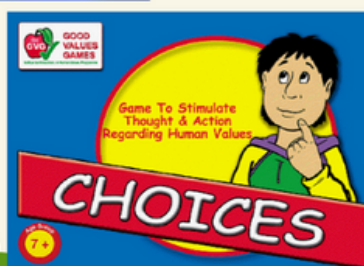


which means not hurting anyone with thought, word or deed. All the values together make you a non violent person
